Main North Road bus priority measures

Dear Resident / Stakeholder

Transit New Zealand (Transit), along with the Christchurch City Council and Environment Canterbury, is considering measures to help improve bus service reliability.

This project is in the early stages of investigation and we would welcome your feedback.

Main North Road will remain as two lanes in each direction for general traffic. However special lanes for buses could be created on the side of the road in the area currently used for car parking. As a result, parking may be reduced.

Transit has sent the enclosed letter, feedback form and flyer to all households and businesses along the route being considered for bus priority measures.

You now have the opportunity, at this early stage of the investigation, to let us know of any opportunities you may be aware of, or concerns you may have, by using the feedback form.

Preliminary concept designs will be on display for you to examine.
