Transmission Gully - Phase II Investigations Planning Resource Services Contract No. NZTA 344PN

Transmission Gully is the proposed 27 km long four-lane divided carriageway highway between MacKays Crossing at Paekakariki and Linden along a "green-fields" route east of SH1, in Wellington's Western Transport Corridor.

The project is currently in Phase II, which consists of the investigations and other work required to prepare for the possible future lodging of applications for the various statutory approvals needed. The statutory approvals required include:

- Planning consents within the four Territorial Authorities affected (Kapiti Coast District, Porirua City, Upper Hutt City and Wellington City Councils) needed to change the existing designations to reflect the preferred alignment
- Regional resource consents (GWRC)
- NZ Historic Places Trust Authority

This tender relates to the work required to prepare the applications for statutory approvals. The Planning Resource Services (PRS) Consultant will be responsible for producing the necessary application documentation (which will include an assessment of environmental effects (AEE)) to obtain the required consents. This will include assisting NZTA in co-ordinating the specialist inputs to the AEE.

The PRS Consultant will also be responsible for producing the following assessments:

- Social impact, community cohesion and public health assessment;
- Cultural and heritage assessment; and
- Land use and transport integration assessment, including access and mobility (in the wider context of the Wellington Western Corridor Plan).

Tender evaluation will be using the quality based method (Brooks Law).
